Our Gospel passage today from Mark's version presents the confidence and assurance with which Jesus begins His ministry of proclaiming the Good News. His words and actions strike the community to the core, inviting the people to change and to respond profoundly. When they hear His words, the truth and originality of Jesus invite them to awe and participation.

The 1st reading excerpt from the book of Deuteronomy presents the work of a prophet:
