 Publication of a commemorative booklet containing all the speeches and homilies of the Pope's apostolic visit and video are available, for purchase, from CCCB Publications.

It's interesting to note that the establishment of the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund was a \$30 million pledge over 5 years. So far, the Fund has raised over one-third of the initial pledge (\$11,264,838) and is on track to meet its goal.
